## The Ugly Face of Capitalism

The power-hungry and autocratic face and nature of Capitalism is now being widely exposed with Donald J. Trump and Elon Musk and their *MAGA* right-wing allies in charge. Their takeover and manipulation of federal agencies is not only an assault on the *US Constitution*, but also a negation of basic human rights and a contradiction of the very meaning of democracy. Trillionaire Elon Musk, appointed by Trump as head of the new *Department of Government Efficiency (DOGE)*, wants to obliterate what he calls the *Deep State* by di-

vesting government agencies of employees and

funding. Thousands of federal employees are being left jobless while adding billions of dollars to Musk and his clique who already control most of the nation's wealth and much of the public media.

Trump charged Musk with the task of reducing the huge federal debt in order to shape a smaller government that gives them full control. In the process, they are endangering the security and the well-being of the nation's people. The recent firing of *FBI* personnel presents a threat to National Security; and Musk's recent dismissal of *United States Aid to International Development (USAID)* employees impacts the quality of life for millions of the poor and needy across the world and will ultimately cause the death of many. Musk's cuts of the *USAID* was seen as so outrageous that even the *Supreme Court (SC)* declared it illegal.

The Trump-appointed *Supreme Court*, however, carries the blame for the chaos that now engulfs America. Thus, the nation's voters are starting to voice their disagreement with Trump's policies and concerns with: major cuts coming in the funding

of *Medicare* and *Medicaid;* the closing of the *United States Agency for International Development (USAID)*; the elimination of thousands of *VA* jobs; the closing of the *Department of Education*; cuts in budgets and personnel of *National Parks,* the direct attacks on the *Transgender* community denying their very humanity and so much more! All of which exposes the totally non-Christian and unscientific biases of a man who claims he was chosen by God to be the President of the US.

Trump's televised "Presidential Address to Congress," on March 4th revealed to Americans his self-glorifying personality as never before. His speech was loaded with self-praise and disregard for the truth. He claimed the Internal Revenue Service was paying millions of retirees whose ages were listed as 109 to 300 or above (not true); he also said that Joe Biden's presidency was the worst ever in American history and that Biden had welcomed thousands of foreign terrorists into the country, (both lies). Trump's address to Congress was unbelievably theatrical and two puppets, namely, Vice President J. D.
