Fuentes Sanchez Lane dedicated to honor elders who founded the Lanier Scholarship Fund

On Tuesday, February 4th, an unnamed alley on San Antonio's historic Westside was named in honor of Amelia Fuentes and Isabel and Enrique Sánchez who spent their time as elders collecting funds for scholarships to encourage students at Lanier High School to attend college. All three had attended Lanier and

Fuentes Sánchez Lane on Tuesday, February 4, 2025. later advocated for their own children who also went to Lanier. Long after their children graduated, Amelia, Isabel and Enrique remained active at Lanier and formed a committee to raise funds for scholarships by selling empanadas, chalupas, tamales, chocolate cake and more at local festivals and school events. The trio even sponsored an annual Lanier Scholarship Dance each spring with DJ El General at the Esperanza Center complete with concession favorites: arroz

The three indefatigable elders made this a part of their life's work in their golden years pausing only when they begin to hit their 90s. Isabel passed in 2021at 98 years old and two vears later so did

The San Antonio City Council eventually approved naming the alley that now assures the public safety of the neighborhood by making it easier to identify an exact location when neighbors close by might call for help. At the same time, it honors the well-deserved work of the Fuentes Sanchez partnership that established the scholarship fund for Lanier High School students. The Fuentes Sanchez Scholarship Fund has now granted more than \$200,000 to collegebound graduates over the past 20 years and continues to impact students.
